

Driving Directions To Diamond S Ranch

Coming from Vail Valley Jet Center

At the airport exit, turn left on Cooley Mesa Road. Travel on Cooley Mesa Road for 1.2 miles until it intersects with Highway 6. Turn right (East) and travel along Highway 6 for 3.6 miles to the roundabout and the intersection of Highway 6 and Eby Creek Road. Continue heading east on Highway 6 for 3.1 miles to the entrance to the ranch on the right.

Coming from Denver International Airport

At the airport exit follow the signs for West bound I-70. Travel West on I-70 for Approximately 120 miles.

You may take the Wolcott exit, #153, turning right at the stop sign. Proceed north to the intersection at Highway 6. turn left and travel west on Highway 6 for 6.8 miles to the entrance of the ranch on the left.

Or

Take exit #147 at Eagle. Turn left from the exit ramp on Eby Creek Road, heading south. Take Eby Creek Road to the end where it intersects with Highway 6 at the roundabout. Make a $\frac{3}{4}$ turn at the roundabout and head east on Highway 6 for 3.1 miles to the entrance of the ranch on the right.

Coming from the Aspen Airport

At the airport exit follow the signs for Colorado Highway 82 north. Take Highway 82 north to Glenwood Springs. In Glenwood Springs, turn left on 6th street. Be sure to use left lane on 6th, turn left onto North River Road (this is not a sharp left turn). Turn left to take the ramp to East bound I-70 towards Denver. Travel along I-70 for 32 miles to Exit# 147 at Eagle. Turn right at exit ramp onto Eby Creek Road. Take Eby Creek Road to the end where it intersects with Highway 6 at the roundabout. Make a $\frac{3}{4}$ turn at the roundabout and head east on Highway 6 for 3.1 miles to the entrance of the ranch on the right.

The address of the ranch is 20616 Highway 6, however there are no numbers anywhere at the entrance to aid in location. There is a four-rail black fence at the entrance flanked by Stone pillars with plaques marked 'Diamond Star Ranch'.

**When you enter there you will come to a security gate that will require a passcode or you may use the call box to gain entry.
Stay on the main road proceeding across the river to your destination.**
